





Life Cycle of Conventional Pool Chemicals



A Natural Swimming Pool – Coming to Webber Park!

Webber Park will be the site of the first public natural-filtration swimming pool the United States. The new pool features a natural filtration system which uses plants in a nearby regeneration pond instead of chemicals to treat the water. At roughly 28,000 square feet, the pool will offer a shallow non-swimmers' area, lap lanes and a diving area. A new bath house and an expanded parking lot are also planned.

A grand opening is slated for August 2014.
